

**REMIXING THE ARTS**

weekly day camps for ages 6 – 12

Atlantic Center for the Arts' Summer Art Camp is held at ACA's Community Arts Center at Harris House in our Yurick Studios. Each weekly session in the nine-week program features three classes that give participants an opportunity to explore ideas of art and culture through hands-on experience with a variety of art forms. There is downtime for snacks, stretching, games, and lunch. Participants will meet new friends and take home artwork every week. This year, the final session will take place at ACA's main campus, in the beautiful Leeper Studios. The *Young Masters* exhibit in ACA's Harris House Gallery will feature artwork made in the first 8 sessions of camp. An opening reception will be held on August 7, featuring artwork and performances by camp participants.

Imagine a customized utopian society with everything just how you like it. Create the landscape, the people, the rules, a secret language, and put it all together in an atlas guide to your own world.

**Save the Robots!****Bryce Hammond** Former ACA artist-in-residence

The robot army needs reinforcements! Build a realistic robot and collaborate with classmates to construct a scale model of a city for the robots to invade.

**Dance Dance Evolution****Amber Johnson**

Explore the evolution of movement in the 20<sup>th</sup> century with a different style each day. Sample styles from Jazz, Swing, Modern, and Hip Hop.

**Session 2: June 22 - 25****Art is a Wonderland****Cathy Berse** IMAGES Artist

Explore the wonderland of art, filled with amazing artists, exciting painting techniques, and a few familiar characters.

**It's a Bird, It's a Plane... It's a Kite!****Martha Lent**

Harness the wind with kites as you have never seen. Create a kite disguised as a work of art, disguised as a person, disguised as a fish, disguised as anything you can imagine.

**African Dance****Yvette Harley**

Ms. Yvette is back with an all new African dance class that will get your feet stomping and your hands clapping! You'll dance to the rhythm of live drums!

**Session 3: June 29 - July 2****Island Living - Ceramics****Annemarie Guzman** NEW TEACHER

Visit the Florida Keys in clay. Sculpt a private island getaway and some coastal friends to bring along on your tropical trip.

**Little Monsters****May Shaw** NEW TEACHER!

First, create an ingenious monster disguise. Next, design and construct a weird and wacky 3D monster buddy while learning about fiber art and plushies.

**Elements of Motion****Ashley Sholtes** Former ACA artist-in-residence

Exploring Body, Space, Force, and Time, this class will be filled with new concepts and movement ideas to help participants discover a movement vocabulary.

**Session 4: July 6 - 9****Wicked Watercolors****Liz Boyer** NEW TEACHER

Learn to paint with watercolor while creating a series of projects that put those new techniques into action.

**Da Da Dreams****Tina Curry**

Let your dreams be your inspiration as you create cut-and-paste creatures and landscapes straight from your imagination.

**Write a Song and Sing Along****Alaia "Shrimpy" Litowitz**

Rearrange and rewrite some songs you know, and create some new songs with live musical accompaniment.

**Session 5: July 13 - 16****Wireworks****Brenda Loring-Smith**

Learn the art of figurative sculpture. Bend and twist wire, then use embellishments to create little people with big personalities.

**Upcycled Art****May Shaw** NEW TEACHER

Reuse and recycle some surprising everyday materials to create a colorful work of outdoor art, and a puppet friend, too!

**Drum Circle****Yvette Harley**

Ms. Yvette is back with D'Jembes and Djun-Djuns for everyone to play the rhythms used in our African dance class.

**Session 6: July 20 - 23****My Mandala Me****Tina Curry**

Transform vinyl records by using paint to create circular tributes to everything that makes you unique.

**Wild & Wacky Weaving****Patti Gerson**

Learn weaving basics while creating a variety of projects such as a handwoven ipod/cell phone case, a tapestry wall hanging and Kumihimo (Japanese Braids).

**Yo Yo Yoga****Liz Boyer** NEW TEACHER

Stretch, bend, twist, and turn as you learn to salute the sun and discover a different kind of movement with yoga.

**Session 7: July 27 - 30****Seriously Silly Storybooks****Steve Hardock** IMAGES Artist

Write a story from your imagination, illustrate your tale with colorful pictures, and then the best part - publish your story!

**To the Beat!****Alaia "Shrimpy" Litowitz** NEW TEACHER

Songs often begin with the beat. Create your own rhythm section by building a variety of instruments and composing original music to play with the group.

**Clay Capers****Yolonda Pelz**

Get your hands dirty in this class that is all about clay. Construct, embellish, and glaze a functional ceramic work of art

**Session 8: August 3 - 6****Master Plaster Blasters****Teresa Thompson** IMAGES Artist

Plaster is one of the most versatile materials used by sculptors. Explore some of its uses by making plaster castings and mosaic sculptures.

**Comic Relief****Peggy Imbert**

Learn about sequential art by creating your own comic strip. Then, add a twist by re-imagining your comic as a fused fabric collage to hang on your wall.

**Movement and Imagery****Ashley Sholtes** Former ACA artist-in-residence

Gestures, pictures, poems, and textures will help you see movement in relation to the sights and sounds of the world and provide you with source material for your own dances.

**Session 9: August 10 - 13****at ACA's Main Campus!****Blow It Up****Bryce Hammond** Former ACA artist-in-residence

Take advantage of the bright open space in the Everbach Painting Studio. This class is all about going big. Start with a small painting - and blow it up!

**Sculpture Totems & Mobiles****Martha Lent**

Create totem poles from found objects and unusual materials, then create, decorate, and assemble a kinetic sculpture to hang from the ceiling.

**Movement and Performance****TBD**

Spring on the sprung-wood dance floor of the Roberson Dance Studio and then wiggle in the spotlights of the Harris Theater.
