



# Atlantic Center for the Arts Summer Art Camp



## Financial Aid Policy

ACA offers three forms of financial aid:

1. General
2. Multiples of three
3. Parent volunteering

Families may receive one form of financial aid per child, with a maximum annual cumulative award of \$300/family. Financial aid is need-based\*, and is awarded with the hope of awarding available funds to as many children as possible, while attempting to meet the needs of all applicants. We cannot guarantee requests will be granted in their entirety.

### **Deposit**

A \$20/child/session deposit, which will be applied to your fee, is required to hold a space in camp, regardless of financial aid awards. Parents may apply for financial aid prior to paying a deposit, but a space is only reserved once the deposit is received.

## **Three forms of financial aid:**

### **General Requests**

We are able to award partial scholarships in a variety of amounts, while funds last. We give very few full scholarships, and only in the case of extreme hardship.

### **Multiples of 3 = 25% off**

Three or more children in one session  
Three or more sessions for one child

### **Parent Volunteers**

Parents may apply to volunteer for a full session to earn a 50% discount for one child for that session. Parent volunteer requests will be approved as space allows.

\*This is based on stated need in 2011. Beginning in 2012, we will require financial aid applicants to provide 1040 tax documentation to support financial aid requests.
